Canadian anti-tobacco activist Errol Povah, 52, protesting outside the Emerging Tobacco Markets 2005 International Tobacco Expo in the Kuala Lumpur Convention Centre yesterday, much to the chagrin of security personnel. Dresses up as the Grim Reaper, Povah is on a mission to create an anti-tobacco awareness among all levels of society. "Allowing the expo to be held in the country is against the Framework Convention on Tobacco Control (FCTC) which the Malaysian prime minister ratified about six months ago as part of the global effort to reduce the tobacco pandemic," the first-timer to Malaysia said.
